Registration Deadline: December 23rd

Registration Info: There are limited spaces available for each age group. Most age groups will fill quickly. Do not wait to register. No team is registered until full payment is received.

Wait List Policy: All leagues are first come first serve. Each league has a designated number of registration spots. Once that league fills we will begin a wait list. If, at the end of sign ups, there is field space to add more games then we will begin taking teams from the waiting list. There is no guarantee a team on the waiting list will get into the league.

League Info(*NEW*): 7 game session. Games on Sundays. Teams may play 1 weeknight game.

Rosters: All teams must turn in completed rosters; with player's names, birthdays, and parents signatures. Rosters will be due at the FIRST week of play.

Player Cards: All players must possess an up to date player card. Cards will be checked against the rosters in our system. Any player not possessing a player card by the 1st week of play will be deemed ineligible. New player cards are \$15 (must show official proof of age), Renewal cards are \$15.

There is a \$50 cancellation fee for any team withdrawing from the league. There is a \$30 returned check fee.

All teams are guaranteed their set number of games per season under all normal circumstances. Crown Sports Center will do everything in their power to make sure any games postponed will be rescheduled. In the case of extreme circumstances, and games cannot be rescheduled, Crown Sports Center reserves the right to terminate the games without refund.
